Dr. Gustavo Bianchi's performance during our last season was so well received that we have invited him back for our January 11th monthly meeting. Dr. Bianchi has enjoyed a distinguished international career, having performed in halls across the United States, South America, and Asia.

Dr Bianchi currently resides in Austin where he earned his doctoral degree from the University of Texas, Austin School of Music, and where he has served as adjunct faculty. He founded and directed the Northwest Hills Chamber Music Festival, and is Vice President of the Austin District Music Teachers Association. In Austin he is a highly sought-out pianist, collaborative artist and teacher. He has also been the pianist at the Bee Creek United Methodist Church in Spicewood, Texas, since 2004.

For his return performance two colleagues – Cellist Dr. **Feng Zhao** and Soprano **MIngyung Lee** – also former graduate students from the University of Texas will accompany him.

Dr. Feng Zhao, born in Tianjin, China, began his cello lessons at age ten. He studied cello at the Shanghai Conservatory with Professor Qian Yi-Shan, a former student of Pablo Casals. After he obtained two Masters degrees in 1995 from Kent State University, he received his degree in Doctor of Musical Arts from University of Texas in 2006. Presently he has been actively presenting recitals and master classes at the University of Texas at Arlington, Indiana University of Pennsylvania, and in the Austin area.

Dr. **MIngyung Lee** has been blessed to perform in various parts of the world including the United States, Taiwan and Korea. She received her Masters of Music in voice performance and her Doctorate of Music in voice performance at the University of Texas in Austin. She taught at Del Mar College in Corpus Christi and is currently a voice faculty at Armstrong Community Music School and works as the music director at St. Luke's United Methodist Church in Kileen, Texas.
