




## New Member Wine and Cheese Party August 17, 2018

Beginning in September, HSLBA will be meeting at the St. Thomas the Apostle Church, 18300 Upper Bay Rd., Nassau Bay. Come out July 7 to see a Lute concert and the beautiful icons on display at St. Thomas the Apostle Church. Information below:

Grammy-nominated lutenist and composer, Ronn McFarlane, will perform at St. Thomas the Apostle Episcopal Church (18300 Upper Bay Road, Nassau Bay) on *July 7<sup>th</sup> from 6:30-8:00 p.m*. He will perform at St Thomas within the Icons Exhibition promising a mesmerizing event.

An internationally acclaimed lutenist, Ronn has the unique ability to bring the beauty of the lute to a wide crossover audience. He is the co-founder of Ayeheart, a founding member of the Baltimore Consort, and has presented concerts in 49 of the 50 states plus several European countries. He has performed extensively as a guest artist including the Houston Grand Opera.

Recognized for his compositional skills, Ronn's emphasis is to build on the tradition of lutenist composers of past centuries. His original compositions are the focus of his solo CD, Indigo Road.

Ronn was a faculty member of the Peabody Conservatory from 1984-1995. He received an honorary Doctorate of Music from Shenandoah Conservatory for his achievements in bringing the lute and its music to the world.

A champagne reception with light refreshments at intermission is included in the ticket price.
