representing the Houston Symphony, to music festivals and concert series appearances in Carnegie Hall. They have performed widely in Texas, Michigan, Arkansas, Puerto Rico, and New York. After a highly successful concert at Carnegie Hall's Weill Recital Hall with clarinetist Danny Granados and friends, the quartet recorded a CD. It was released in March 2019 by Delos.
