Danielle Harmon began playing the harp at five years old, performing as a soloist and member of lesson studio harp ensembles from a young age. Danielle specifically continued on with the harp to complete both a Bachelor of Music & Master of Music from the University of North Texas (majoring in Performance both degrees). During the second and final year of her Masters studies, she was one of seven UNT Concerto Competition winners.

Danielle is the current principal harpist for the Monroe Symphony Orchestra in NE Louisiana

(since 2012). She previously held principal harp positions with the Lubbock Symphony Orchestra (2011-2012) and Lone Star Wind Orchestra in Dallas/Fort Worth (2006-2014). She has also performed with regional ensembles such as the San Angelo Symphony, Flowermound Symphony, Metropolitan Winds in Dallas, Pine Bluff Symphony in Arkansas, and Brazosport Symphony. Danielle will frequently accompany the Bay Area Chorus and Bay Area Youth Singers of the Houston-Clear Lake area as harp is requested. She is also a performing member of the newly-founded New Houston Harp Ensemble.

Occasionally Danielle will sing and play the harp at the same time, but most of her vocal experience is choral. She sang in the Youth Choir of Clear Lake Presbyterian Church during her intermediate and high school years, adding contemporary worship band and the adult Chancel Choir to the mix during her high school years. Danielle then also joined the Clear Brook High School mixed/varsity choir her junior and senior years while there.

Danielle works for Clear Lake United Methodist Church as the administrative assistant for the Music & Fine Arts Ministry. She directs their Morning Bells handbell ensemble in both weekly rehearsals and semi-annual outreach performances.


Ride the Bus with HSLBA to the Symphony!
